Mississippi Medical Cannabis Program Provider/Patient Memorandum of Understanding

The Mississippi Medical Cannabis program:

Legal Authority: Cannabis Act, S.B. 2095, Mississippi Legislature Regular Session 2022, Section 4 (1) (3) and Section 21

Pursuant to rule 2.9.3 as listed from the act above, the in-person visit will be scheduled and establish a Bona-fide practitioner-patient relationship. You will be examined in Mississippi and Ekaa Healthcare LLC will determine based on medical record review if you suffer from a Debilitating Medical Condition for which the use of medical cannabis may mitigate the symptoms and/or the effects.

Ekaa Healthcare LLC will NOT EXAMINE new patients for the purpose of determining IF patient has a particular medical condition that qualifies for Medical Cannabis. Medical records must be submitted prior to in-person visit.

A copy of your certification will be placed in your medical record and can be retrieved from your portal.

Ekaa Healthcare LLC will be available to provide follow-up care and treatment to the individual seeking certification/recertification.

Your certification is valid for 12 months from the date of issuance.

Certifications for patients between 18 and 25 require two separate practitioners from two separate practices. Rule 2.9.9.

Ekaa Healthcare LLC is prohibited from referring patients to specific medical cannabis establishments, to specific caregivers, or advertising in medical cannabis establishments.

Ekaa Healthcare LLC will utilize the Prescription Monitoring Program in order to complete an assessment of the patient prior to issuing a written certification for the medical cannabis program.

Patient acknowledges their freedom of choice as to the medical cannabis dispensary they wish to utilize. Evidence of this must/will be maintained in the patient's medical record.

Ekaa Healthcare LLC may determine that a patient no longer meets the requirements related to a debilitating medical condition; no longer believes that the patient receives therapeutic benefit from the use of medical cannabis; or does not believe the patient is using the medical cannabis for medical purposes. The practitioner must notify the Department of that determination and intent to terminate the practitioner certification. Termination of practitioner certification renders the patient identification card null and void.
